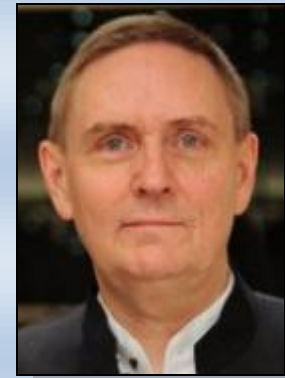

Dr. Roger W. Harris is a Visiting Professor at ISITI-UNIMAS and has a PhD in Information Systems from the City University of Hong Kong. He taught in UNIMAS during 1997-2001 when he instigated and led the pioneering and multi-award winning eBario Telecentre Project. He remains closely involved with eBario as a Director of eBario Sdn Bhd, the organisation that now operates the telecentre and other projects. Dr. Harris is the founder of Roger Harris Associates, a consulting and social entrepreneurial firm that provides services to Asian governments and aid agencies, including the United Nations, the World Bank and the Asian Development Bank. He has worked on projects in; Bangladesh, Cambodia, China, India, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Mongolia, Nepal, Papua New Guinea, Philippines, Sri Lanka and Vietnam. Dr. Harris has published many research papers; he inaugurated the *Electronic Journal on Information Systems in Developing Countries*, of which he is currently co-Editor-in-Chief, and is also editor/reviewer for several other academic journals. His book titles include, *From Research to Practice: Building ICTD Research Capacities in Asia*, *Empowering the Poor: Information and Communications Technology for Governance and Poverty Reduction - A Study of Rural Development Projects in India*, *Information Systems in Developing Countries: Theory and Practice*, and *Information and Communication Technologies for Poverty Alleviation*.
